as dry as possible. To develop this new design, Sundance went the extra mile, using high-speed video equipment to watch how spray reacted to the hull design. Designing a dry skiff does not mean sacrificing

shoal water performance. The B series floats in a mere 6 inches of water. The Sundance Bay series 171 and 201 are budget friendly boats, but they don't sacrifice stout construction. These models have 8-inch wide box-beam foam-cored fiberglass stringers, high-density composite transoms, and .125-inch thick aluminum fuel tanks. TRITON is a name that's synonymous with quality, speed, and high performance. In 2006, this builder continues producing boats with zero-flex stringer construction, hand-laid fiberglass, and Triton core composites. Their newest offering for the 2006 model year is the 190 CC, their smallest center console, but a little boat that can fish with the big

boys. The flagship of the fleet is Triton's 351 CC, one of the boats that pioneered the new class of mega-consoles over 30 feet that runs at tournament-level speeds in excess of 53-mph on triple 225-hp Honda outboards. This boat provides 75 gallons of livewell space in 50- and 25-gallon livewells, and even sports tuna tubes. The Triton LTS series flats boats are the official boat of the Redfish Cup, and offer another tournament-level line that serious anglers must be aware of. Triton's goal with each of their tournament boats is to bring you the fastest, sleekest boats in the running, which will get you to the hotspot more quickly and drier than the other competitors.
